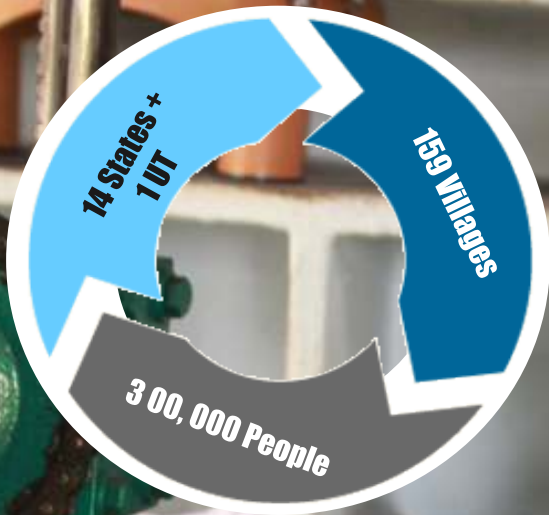

FXB India Suraksha is an Indian NGO providing integrated developmental assistance to marginalised families and communities in rural and urban India to reduce their vulnerabilities in respect of poverty, health, education and protection. FXBIS's vision is to see an India, in which children and women lead self-reliant and empowered lives, achieving their full potential in a healthy, poverty free and protective environment.

FXBIS works in four programme domains:



Livelihood Promotion

Improve living standards and economic self-sufficiency of families through skill training and new livelihood opportunities.



Improved health status

Improve access to quality health services, drinking water and sanitation facilities for the communities.



Access to quality education

Improved access to quality education for children and youth through financial and tutorial support.



Protection and Safety

Preventing and reducing child abuse, gender-based violence, human trafficking and stigma and discrimination through proactive and reactive mechanisms.





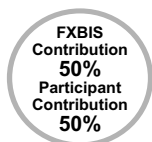

The three year integrated intervention- The FXBVillage Programme

FXB India Suraksha focuses on empowering families through its flagship FXBVillage programme. This programme provides a holistic, integrated solution which delivers investment in the long-term wellbeing of families and communities.

The three year integrated intervention is designed to target the links between economic poverty, health, education and human rights. With the aim to empower the community by investing in individuals and equipping them with the training and resources needed to achieve lasting self-sufficiency and stability. Each FXBVillage programme is customized to meet the needs specific to a community with respect to its social, cultural, political, geographical and economic backdrop.

Economic security is being provided through skill development trainings and establishing of income generation activities (IGA) in form of social enterprises. Other features of the intervention include medical care and nutritional support, psychological counselling, awareness campaigns on and access to water and sanitation services as well as educational assistance. These direct forms of support are gradually reduced over the three-year period as families gradually take charge of meeting their basic needs. The ultimate goal is for participants to achieve and maintain a life of self-sufficiency.



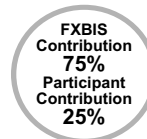

Livelihood Promotion

FXB India Suraksha envisions an India in which women and families lead self-reliant and empowered lives. With that vision, FXBIS has been establishing skill-based employment opportunities for women and strengthen individual and community-based capacities to run and grow the businesses.

FXBIS focuses on reviving traditional livelihood avenues using local resources and transference of technology. Women members of the FXBIS Self Help Groups participate in comprehensive training programmes which equip them with the skills to sustainably run their businesses. Self Help Groups are linked with cooperatives, financial institutions and government schemes for micro financing opportunities and linkages with market opportunities for products and services are facilitated by FXBIS.

FXBIS has assisted women to become skilled and self-reliant. Currently, 15 women-led enterprises are running in four states.

Improved Health Status

FXB India Suraksha recognizes that good health is a fundamental human right and a precondition for social development. A paramount objective of all FXBIS programmes is to address health vulnerabilities by improving access to quality health services, clean water and sanitation facilities within its intervention geographies. The overall impact of the FXBIS Health Strategy is a significant decrease of communicable and vector borne diseases as well as infant, maternal and child mortality rates within communities.

FXBIS's comprehensive health agenda includes direct support in form of health camps, care and support services for people living with HIV/AIDS (PLHIV), supplementary nutrition and counselling. Through its intensive Behavioural Change Communication (BCC) campaigns, FXBIS aims to educate children, families and whole communities about issues concerning health and hygiene, improve health seeking behaviour, promote the usage of effective water and sanitation techniques and create demand for low-cost toilets.

Access to quality health services is provided to the communities to promote health seeking behavior.

Access to Quality Education

FXB India Suraksha believes that the universal access to quality education is the key to effective and sustainable social change. The FXBIS Education Strategy aims to raise awareness about the importance of education and enhance access to and quality of education. FXBIS envisioned impact are well educated, confident, productive and socially responsible children and youth.

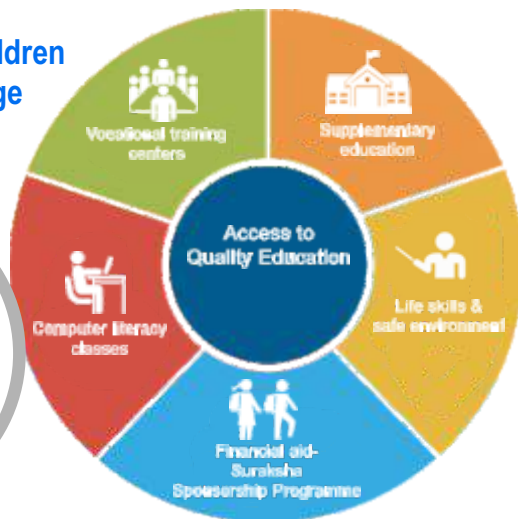
FXBIS helps local schools to improve their infrastructure and basic amenities and help families in need to raise funds for school education by linking them to government education schemes or provide sponsorships via the Suraksha Sponsorship programme.

In the Suraksha Education Centers children can access educational support from qualified tutors and supplementary learning materials. FXBIS Computer Literacy Centres bridge the digital divide by equipping children and youth with access to and knowledge about modern technology. FXBIS empower women and youth through non-formal education programmes such as 'Life Skill Workshops' and vocational training courses.

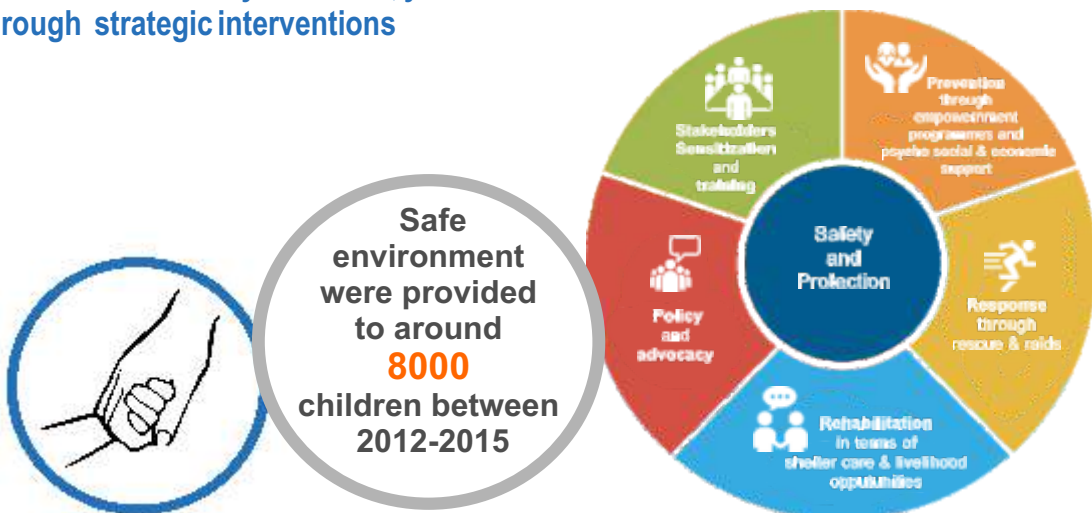


Protection and Safety

An integral part of all FXBIS programmes is to prevent and reduce all forms of violation and exploitation of children and women which includes gender-based violence, human trafficking, child labour, child marriages, commercial sexual exploitation and incidences of stigma and discrimination within its programme geographies. The ultimate objective is to create a safe, secure and protective environment for women, youth and children.

The FXBIS Protection and Safety strategy focuses on preventive measures in form of building capacities among adolescents and community members, raise awareness, and stakeholder sensitization programmes. FXBIS works with the local youth, girls and boys, to train them as peer educators and built a cadre for agents of change within their own communities. Survivors of violence are assisted through immediate intervention and link with central and state sponsored services for their rehabilitation through referral, after care and counseling services.

FXBIS Projects Portfolio

Railway Children Care & Support (Jaipur, Rajasthan): The Suraksha Day Care Centre adopts individualistic approach to provide a safe haven for children living at the Jaipur Railway Station where they can access medical and educational support, rest, wash-up, eat, participate in recreational activities and simply be children again.

ChildLine (Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh): FXBIS is the collaborative partner for CHILDLINE, India's first 24 hour emergency outreach service for children in need of care and protection. It is supported under Integrated Child Protection Scheme by Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India.

FXBVillage (Imphal East, Manipur): The FXBVillage Imphal East works closely with HIV/AIDS affected families & children to reduce the overall vulnerabilities in respect of livelihoods, health, education and protection.

FXBVillage (Villupuram, Tamil Nadu): The FXBVillage Nesal works closely with the local dalit community to reduce the overall vulnerabilities in respect of livelihoods, health, education and protection.

Integrated Community Development Programme (Sanyasikuppam village, Pondicherry):

The project is designed to bring improvements in living standards, social exclusion, quality education, health and hygiene, and improve care and support of the elderly.

Water & Sanitation project (Ranchi, Jharkhand): In Ranchi, Jharkhand, FXBIS works towards developing safe water and sanitation systems at the village level and strengthening the capacities of community institutions to manage the local WATSAN infrastructure effectively in govt. collaboration.

Slum Intervention Programme (Noida, Uttar Pradesh): Located in Sector 16, the project works towards improving the overall health status and wellbeing of the local people in the slum area by providing educational support and access to health services. Vocational training is being provided to around 100 women & youths from the area.

Care & Support to People Living with HIV Aids (Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh): FXBIS provides additional support services to HIV/AIDS affected families in form of viral load testing, counselling, treatment of opportunistic infections, supplementary nutrition, education and community sensitization activities.

Women Empowerment Projects (Amalapuram, Andhra Pradesh): FXBIS establishes new or strengthens existing community-based, collective livelihood units, which provides skill training workshops and access to livelihood assets for the women and promotes market access and micro credit options.

Skill Building and Livelihood Promotion for Rural Poor (Ri-Bhoi, Meghalaya): Implemented in 10 villages of Ri-Bhoi district, the project equips local women to establish agro-allied enterprises through product processing and marketing and facilitates skill training and employment promotion activities for the local youth.

Youth Empowerment in Tribal Village (Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh): FXBIS runs a Youth Empowerment Centre and Library at Kodeli Village which provides a venue for young people to read, study and meet up.

Vihaan (Northeast India): FXBIS is India HIV/AIDS Alliance's implementing partner in the states of Assam, Mizoram, Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Tripura and Meghalaya. The project works towards scaling up care and support as well as treatment services in HIV/AIDS affected communities in active partnerships with local NGO's, CBO's & Positive networks.

MUKTI Project (Imphal & Ukhrul, Manipur): A comprehensive community-driven intervention- the project will help to empower women, local communities and district administration and build their capacities to effectively counter child trafficking.

The MSM Targeted Intervention project (Aizawal, Mizoram): The project works towards preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS among the high risk group through community mobilization and sensitisation, behavioural change communication, STI management and referral to government services.



Monitoring & Evaluation and Research Portfolio

FXB India Suraksha has a robust Monitoring and Evaluation system spread across all its projects for result oriented performance.

Our Monitoring and Evaluation involves strategic planning and continuous tracking of progress to ensure informed decision making on programme specifics / components and allocation and reallocation of resources across our projects.



The Research wing at FXBIS aims at improving the quality of life of women and children of marginalized families and communities to reduce their vulnerabilities in rural and urban India.
